### **Course outline**

#### We will be exploring the wonderful world of Pen & Wash.

The fascinating history of line making with bamboo and reed pens, quills (learn how to make them yourself), steel nibs and the modern throw away pens. Each has their own quality of line.

You will experience first-hand the excitement of the reaction of paint and ink with water. This medium, in its many guises, is a vibrant, immediate form of painting - both as finished work or as a useful 'en plein air' tool for reference material.

Although often used for painting buildings and street scenes, it is very versatile and may be used for any subject.
